

# 2017 Summer Party Regatta for the Harbor Heritage Perpetual Trophy **NOTICE OF RACE** August 19, 2017 at the Balboa Bay Club

## Fleet 1 of the Harbor 20 Class Association

### 1. GENERAL

- 1.1. The regatta is a part of the Harbor 20 Fleet 1 Summer Party hosted by the Mariners Club of the Balboa Bay Club (BBC).
- 1.2. The regatta will be comprised of at least one race. Regatta format to be determined.
- 1.3. Fill your boat as desired with family, friends, pets, and refreshments.
- 1.4. "Heritage" theme boat decoration and colorful crew attire is encouraged and will be considered in awarding the Harbor Heritage Perpetual Trophy.

### 2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2. RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be changed so that only a One-Turn Penalty (one tack and one gybe) is required.
- 2.3. US Sailing prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 will be deleted.
- 2.4. The races are not designated Fleet Races by Harbor 20 Fleet 1.
- 2.5. Harbor 20 Fleet 1 Bylaw I.G regarding Fleet Race Divisions will apply; however, the Race Committee may assign a skipper to a Division for this regatta.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all Harbor 20 boats.
- 3.2. Registrants must be members in good standing with the Harbor 20 Class Association and registered for the Summer Party to be eligible to sail in this event. Entry fee for racing is \$45 per boat, and includes 2 tickets for the Summer Party. Tickets for the Summer Party are \$25 per person. Registration to the Summer Party and Regatta must be made online at the Harbor 20 Class Association website ([www.Harbor20.org](http://www.Harbor20.org)) no later than August 18.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available before 0900 on August 19 on the Harbor 20 website and/or at BBC. Amendments to the Sailing Instructions may be announced by the Race Committee at the Skippers meeting.

#### RACING

- 5.1. One race for each Division is scheduled.
- 5.2. The race will start and finish in the harbor south of the Balboa Bay Club.
- 5.3. The race will be a random leg course. The course for each Division's race will be announced at the competitors meeting.
- 5.4 Details will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

### 6. SCORING

- 6.1 Low Point Scoring System in RRS Appendix A will apply, except that no scores will be excluded.

### 7. PRIZES

- 7.2 Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 boats to finish in each division.
- 7.2. The Harbor Heritage Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the boat determined by the Race Committee to be the winner.

### 8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 8.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this regatta participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (Organizing Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
